- ❖ **WHERE:** The Portland Playhouse (231 Maple St. Portland, MI 48875)
- ❖ **WHEN:** June 18th – July 29th, 2018 (Monday-Friday with weekend performances)

- ❖ **DEADLINE: Applications must be submitted by Friday, June 8th.** Spaces are limited, and students will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. All applicants beyond the available spots will be added to the waiting list. **If your child is put on the waiting list, there is no guarantee they will be able to participate in Summer Theatre this year.**
- ❖ **PLEASE NOTE:** Your registration form must be completely filled out and your registration fee paid in order to be considered for admission into the program.
- ❖ *If your participant will be absent from the program for cumulatively more than a week, we ask that they do not participate.*

DATES & TIMES (Subject to change based on enrollment)

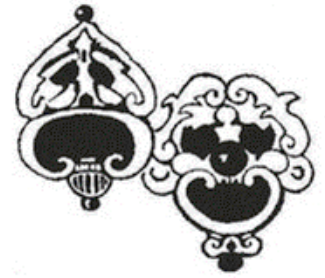
- ❖ *A more detailed calendar will be sent home the first week!*
- ❖ Following the first two weeks of the program, the directors will divide the participants into three sessions.
- ❖ WEEKS ONE and TWO
 - June 18-28, Monday-Friday
 - 9-11:00am: Participants going into grades 4-6
 - 10:30am-12:30pm: Participants going into grades 7-12
 - June 29 (Friday), 9am-12pm, All Participants
- ❖ WEEKS THREE through SIX (*the sixth week's schedule will be altered for dress rehearsals and performances with a required clean and strike on Sunday, July 29th prior to the cast party*)
 - SESSION A
 - Rehearsals Mon-Fri 8-10am
 - Dress Rehearsal: July 19th (*tentative*)
 - Performances: July 25th and 28th (*tentative*)
 - SESSION B
 - Rehearsals Mon-Fri 10am-12pm
 - Dress Rehearsal: July 20st (*tentative*)
 - Performances: July 26th and 28th (*tentative*)
 - SESSION C
 - Rehearsals Mon-Fri 12-2pm
 - Dress Rehearsal: July 23th (*tentative*)
 - Performances: July 27th and 29th (*tentative*)
- ❖ **The week of July 4th we will rehearse Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday, with OPTIONAL parade participation on Wednesday (the 4th).**
